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COLLEGE COLOURS POLICY

1. College colours are awarded to students who qualify by satisfying the criteria set out in this document and who carry themselves in a manner that is exemplary in and around the College. They have to demonstrate a pride in the College, its uniform and regulations including good standing status for attendance and participation. The final decision is made by the Colours committee comprising of the referees for each category, chaired by the Dean of Secondary.
2. All College colours for years 7 to 11 are awarded at the end of the year's final awards assembly. Year 12 colours are awarded at the year 12 Graduation Ceremony.
3. Application forms (available at Student Services and on Seqta Learn and Seqta Engage) have to be handed in to the staff coordinating each area by week 3 of term 4 for years 7 to 11 and by week 7 of term 3 for year 12 students.
4. Referees of each area take their nominations to the Colours committee for a final decision in Week 7 of the respective terms.
5. Students receiving colours will be informed of the date on which they will be awarded College colours, and students who are unsuccessful in their application will receive feedback from their respective referees.

Academic Colours: Coordinator: Associate Dean of Secondary

Academic Colours and half colours are awarded at the end of each academic year: at the final Year 7-11 Awards assembly and the Year 12 graduation ceremony.

Award	Criteria
Academic Half Colours	<p>Students in Years 7-10 who have achieved an “A” grade in the top class for English, Maths, Science & HASS, and an “A” grade average across all subjects.</p> <p>Students in Year 11 and Year 12 who have achieved an “A” grade average across a minimum of five ATAR courses.</p>
Academic Full Colours	<p>Students in Years 7-10 who have achieved “A” grades across all subjects (with an academic component), and are in the top classes for English, Maths, Science & HASS.</p> <p>Students in Year 11 and Year 12 who have achieved “A” grades across all subjects with a minimum of five ATAR courses</p>

Note: “A” Grade average is calculated by allocating points to the grades as follows:

“A” grade – 4 points

“B” grade – 3 points

“C” grade – 2 points

“D” grade – 1 point

Points are then aggregated and averaged, and an average of 3.5 or higher is considered an “A” grade average.

This would then include examples such as

- i) 3 “A”s and 1 “C”
- ii) 2 “A”s and 2 “B”s

House Colours:

House Colours or half colours are awarded to students who add significant value to the House system by being involved in House based activities and events throughout the year, including:

- House based events in any of the learning areas
- House based College community events
- involvement in Cadet House platoon activities

House colours and half colours are awarded at the end of each academic year: at the final Year 7-11 Awards assembly and the Year 12 Graduation Ceremony.

Service Colours:

Service Colours are awarded to students who add significant value to the College by being involved in service activities and events throughout their College life. This category is the only “non-performance/standards based category”. A student’s service is recognised throughout their secondary schooling years by service pins (as described in the “Service Pins Policy”. Once a student receives the gold level 3 service pin status (54 hours of service) they are eligible for service colours upon completing the next 6 hours of service.
